Question marks

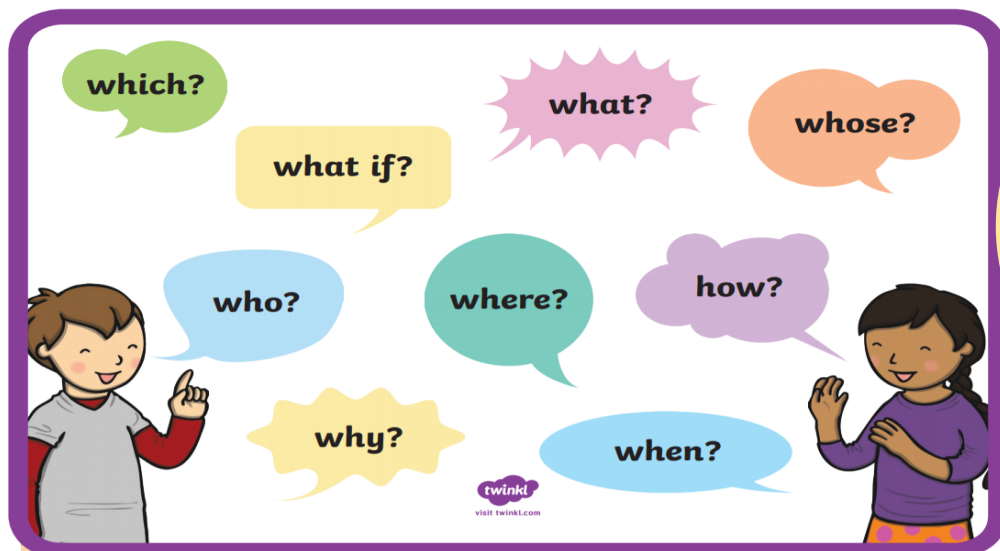
This is a very strange picture! Write a list of all of the questions that this picture makes you think of.
