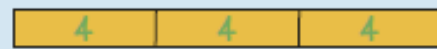




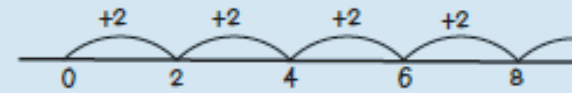
Double 3 is 6

 2 groups of 3 = 6



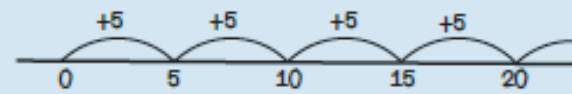
3 groups of 4



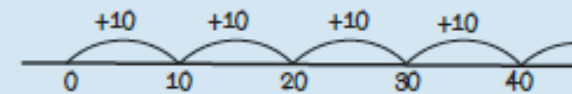
Three groups of 4  
 $4 + 4 + 4 = 12$



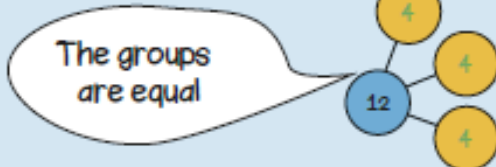

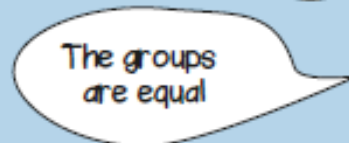
The groups are equal

 6 shared equally into 2 groups is 3 in each group

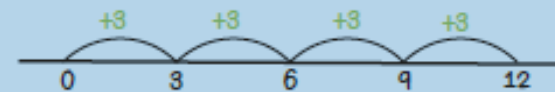


12 divided equally into 3 groups is 4 in each group
